
Key Vocabulary	
gouache	is one type of paint consisting of natural pigment, water, a binding agent. it is similar to watercolour and is designed to be opaque.
unity	is forming a complete and harmonious whole.
continuous	is forming an unbroken whole, without interruption.
repetition	is when something is repeated.
Layered	is when things are arranged in layers- one on top of the other.
replicated	is to make a copy of or reproduce.
contrast	is when something is strikingly different from something else.
cut outs	is to remove or make something separate.
collages	is a piece of art made by sticking various different materials on to a backing.

Henri Matisse

(1869-1954)



Matisse was a French artist known for his use of colour and shape. When he was young, he did lots of paintings but as he grew older he began to make striking collages, which are pictures made by using cut out bits of paper. The Polynesia, The Sea, was created by Matisse using gouache and paper cut outs. In this art, Matisse has created the sea using different coloured blocks as the background and has then used white paper to cut out sea creatures and plants. He has created unity through the continuous seaweed border and the repeated patterns.
