Dear Parents

Following the installation of the zebra crossing and extended road markings, I'd like to share with you the contraventions relating to parking on the yellow and white zig zags outside school;

Contravention 48 – Stopped in a restricted area outside a school – No observation time instant penalty no loading or drop off or pick up.

These can be given by Civil Enforcement Officer by hand, placed on the car, or by post if detected on the basis of evidence from an approved device. With a camera and associated recording equipment.

Zig zag markings outside of schools are installed for the protection of the children. Any markings that are restricted are governed by the relative Traffic Regulation Order and have yellow lines and a time plate showing hours of operation. Any vehicle parked in a restricted bay, during the times shown on the plate, will be issued with a PCN which will not be cancelled under any circumstances including the claim that the driver was picking up or dropping off children.

Contravention 99 – Stopped on a pedestrian crossing or a crossing area marked by zigzags – No observation time instant penalty no loading or drop off or pick up.

The PCN rate for the above two contraventions parking in a restricted area outside a school and pedestrian crossing has a penalty of £70.00 for Cheshire West and Chester. If paid within 14 days of issue the PCN rate is discounted by 50% and £35.00 will be accepted in full settlement.
