

Key Vocabulary

3D	3D means three-dimensional, i.e., something that has width, height and depth (length).
layering	Layer means to put things on top or in front of each other.
joining	To connect two materials together, this can be done by gluing, taping, etc.
shaping	To cut the design to the desired shape.
product	Something that is made to be sold, usually something that is produced by an industrial process.
reinforce	To strengthen or support an object, especially with additional material.
