ELTON'S FAVORITE FOR RE AND P4C

RE and P4C during Elton Primary School Autumn Term



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Years 5 and 6 have both been discussing equality and how it doesn't matter who you are and what you look like, people should be treated equally. We also discussed the rights of children and opinions and fact.

RE in Years 5 and 6 has been about Christianity, and the stories that Jesus told, including Daniel's story.

Years 3 & 4 have been learning about Jesus the Healer in RE lessons and learnt the story of the Good Samaritan. They also learnt about how Jesus healed the paralysed man.

For P4C, Years 3 and 4 have been learning about conflict and resolution. They also discussed the royal family following Prince Harry's engagement to Meghan Markle.

In Years 1 and 2, the children have been learning about the Nativity story most recently, alongside practising for their performance. They also learnt about some the stories Jesus told like Noah's Ark and The Good Shepherd.

P4C in Years 1 and 2 has been all about friendship and respect. They have been talking about how we show that we care for people and how we treat others.

In EYFS, Reception class have been finding out about the

Church, what churches are like on the inside and about the names of the different parts of the church. In P4C they have been learning about how to be a good friend, and that sharing is caring. Both Nursery and Reception class have been finding out about the Nativity story. Nursery class also made some models of Jesus in DT.

Across the whole school, each class has had lessons on Democracy and Anti-Bullying during those weeks. Different classes discussed a variety of issues, such as why bullying is a problem and how bullying makes people feel. Year 6 had a general election, where they chose to vote for different people's visions.
