What do we do to support behaviour?

- All staff will work together to look for triggers and try to prevent these happening.
- The teacher or key stage lead will meet with parents to discuss the behaviour and work together.
- Mrs Higginson will work with the child and teacher to look at strategies which can be implemented.
- Mrs Higginson will have informal check-ins throughout the week to review behaviour and praise any successes.
- Mrs Higginson will work alongside the class teacher and parent to support the child and to review strategies.
- Mrs Morphet (SENDCo) may support the teacher and pupil.
- Mrs Deakin, our trained ELSA, may support children with emotional needs.
- It may be that we offer the opportunity to attend a lunchtime nurture club.
- Mrs Deakin, our trained LEGO therapy staff member, may run an intervention.
- We may contact the Education Access Team to ask for advice and support.
- We constantly review our practice and policy, looking at staff and pupil voice.
