

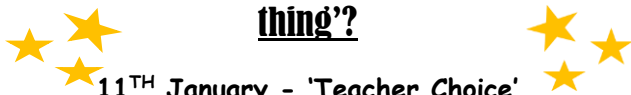

What do we offer to support behaviour?

Nurture Club: Lunchtimes can be a vulnerable time for some children so that is why we run a KS1 and KS2 Nurture Club to support children with this time and to ensure that they are ready for their afternoon lessons. Each group is carefully created to be bespoke to the group of children. Participants are carefully chosen, and the activities undertaken range depending on the needs of the individuals. If you feel this is something your child will benefit from, then please speak to Mrs Higginson, our Behaviour Lead and SENDCo.

Mrs Deakin: Mrs Deakin is our fantastic Learning Mentor. She runs a range of interventions to support our children with their behaviour and she is always willing to support children and parents with any questions. She is trained in delivering ELSA; LEGO Therapy; Cognitive Behaviour Therapy; Drawing and Talking Trauma Therapy; Mental Health First Aid; counselling for children and adolescents; bereavement, loss and change; Drawing and Talking Therapy; 123 Magic Parenting; and has been on recent ADHD and autism training. If you need any advice or support, then please do not hesitate to speak to Mrs Deakin, she can usually be found on the playground each morning.



Behaviour Lead

Mrs Higginson has been the Behaviour Lead since September 2017. She is based in the Year 6 classroom during the morning and is working as the SENDCo during the afternoon and is more than happy to support you with any queries. She has recently been on a range of training to support her in her role and is constantly reviewing behaviour within the school.
