FIXED PENALTY NOTICE

We are required to remind parents that any request to take your child out of school for a holiday will be deemed unauthorised unless it is due to exceptional circumstances. An unauthorised absence of 5 days or more is subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN).

Should you still choose to take a holiday of 5 days or more then the Local Authority will be informed. A Fixed penalty Notice will then be issued in accordance with section 444 of the Education Act 1996. The law stipulates that the current penalties payable by parents are £60 when the penalty is paid within 21 days and £120 when the penalty is paid within 28 days. This penalty is per parent/carers per child. If the fixed penalty is not paid this could lead to you being prosecuted in the Magistrates' Court.
