We will be practising our times tables up to 12x12 every day in class and it would be great if you would continue this at home so that we can become really fluent!

PE

Occasionally, we may give out a piece of homework that lasts for a longer period of time, such as a mini-project. You need to continue to learn your times tables at home as well as covering them in class, there will be a times table test every Friday. Finally, spellings will be given out each term and should be practised daily.

Year 4 Learning Leaflet


Autumn 2020

Our first topic will focus on environmental regions around the world. To link with our book we are studying in English, we will be looking at natural environments of gorillas and other apes around the world.

In **Science** this term, we will be focusing on the units animals including humans and sound. We will learn about the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans and identify the different types of teeth in humans. During our sound unit, we will identify how sounds are made and find patterns between the pitch and volume of a sound

This year, we will deliver Art and DT in blocks at the end of the half terms. In **Art** we will be designing and creating circus posters; looking at different artists for inspiration. In **DT** we will develop our skills in textiles by creating a fairground game/mechanical toy.

In **English** we will be focusing our learning around two books called Gorilla by Anthony Browne and Leon and the Place Between by Graham Baker-Smith. Throughout the term, we will focus on letter writing and narrative recounts as well as completing extended writing within our topic work. Throughout the year, we will continue to develop our use of ambitious vocabulary, conjunctions, punctuation and sentence openers.



In **Maths** we will be following the White Rose Maths scheme of work, which develops the children's fluency with number and their mastery at applying these skills to problems and puzzles. We will start with work on number placement, addition and subtraction as well as multiplication and division. We will also continue to build on our recall of times tables.

In **Computing** we will be looking at Internet Safety. What makes a strong password? What makes a spam? What rules should we follow on the web?

Our **geography** this term will be taught through our topic of **Gorillas**. We will learn about the physical geography based on gorilla's habitats and develop our enquiry skills further by comparing the environment differences between gorillas and other apes. Within Geography, we will continue to build upon our knowledge of maps and atlases. In **history**, we will be learning about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.




In **Music** we will have weekly sessions on Tuesday afternoon. We will be following the Charanga theme which allows children to focus on each aspect of the musical curriculum.



In **R.E** we will be learning about Judaism. We will be learning about their beliefs and views. We will look into synagogues and what happens during Pesach for Jews. We will also be learning about the rules that Jews follow in the Torah.

In **French** we will continue to develop our skills in conversational French and learn about the culture.



In **PE** we will be covering dance and invasion games including football and tag rugby. Throughout the year, we will also continue to have the opportunity to participate in competitions. PE will be on a Monday and Friday so please ensure labelled kit is with you on these days.
