How to create tie dye

Tie dye is the production of patterns in (a garment or piece of cloth) by tying parts of it to shield it from the dye to create a patchwork effect.



Key Vocabulary

tie dye	A resist-dyeing technique which typically consists of folding, twisting, pleating, or crumpling fabric or a garment and binding with string or rubber bands
patchwork	Needlework where small pieces of cloth are sewn together
batik	A technique of wax-resist dyeing which originated from Indonesia
applique	Decorate with pieces of fabric to form pictures or patterns
transfer	An act of moving something from one place to another
embroidery	Craft of decorating fabric using a needle



Patchwork

Patchwork is the craft of sewing in which small pieces of cloth of different designs, colours or textures are sewn together.



Batik

An Indonesian method of printing on fabric by hand with wax or glue. Parts are avoided not to be covered to create a patterned effect.
