



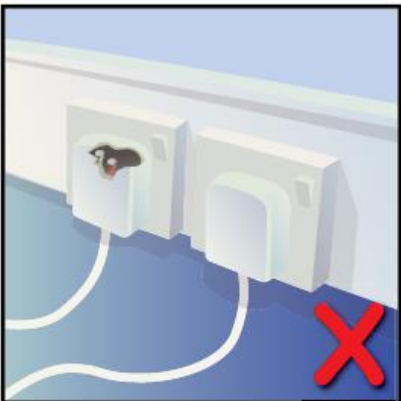
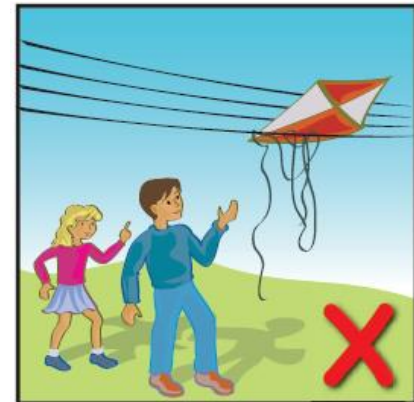
# Free Electricity Safety Presentation & Resources for your school

## What do you get from your PowerWise Visit?



### Key Stage 1

In a 30 minute interactive presentation pupils are introduced to the potential dangers of electricity in the home and learn how to stay safe, for example, how to put a plug into a socket correctly and how to teach an adult how to remove bread that is stuck inside a toaster! Pupils then participate in an exercise to learn how to recognise electrical equipment outdoors, such as substations and power lines, and essentially to recognise the 'Danger of Death' warning sign.

In a plenary session pupils are introduced to Sparky, our 'clued up' crow puppet who checks their understanding of the main safety elements of the session.

### Key Stage 2

In a 60 minute session the key issues from the Key Stage 1 lessons are covered but we introduce scientific vocabulary such as 'conductor' and 'insulator'. We also explore the outdoor dangers at greater depth and ensure pupils recognise electrical apparatus that helps to get electricity from the power station to your home and understand why not to play near it as they gain greater independence.

A PowerWise quiz forms the plenary where children are asked questions on the session and have the opportunity to win small PowerWise prizes!
