## WORLD BOOK DAY—FANCY DRESS SWAP

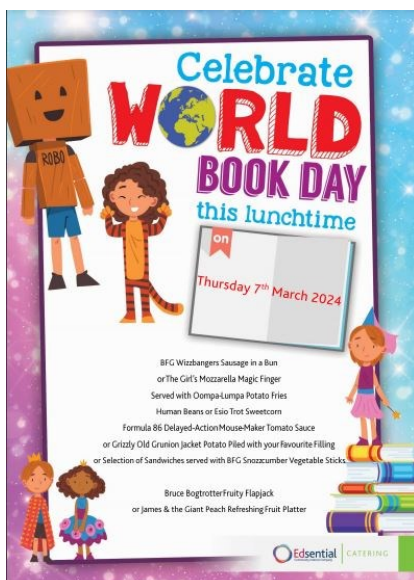
Do your bit to help save the environment and money this year, by donating
