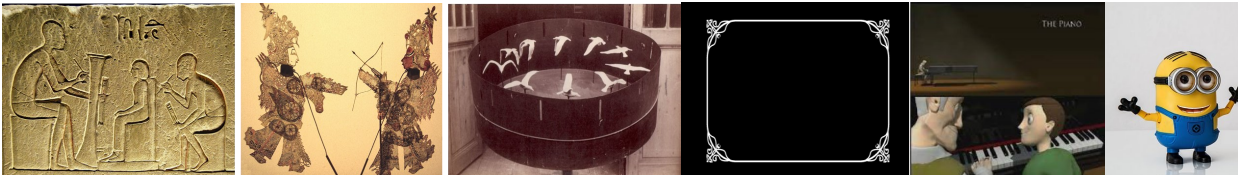




## What should I already know?

**Video:** the recording, reproducing or broadcasting of moving visual images

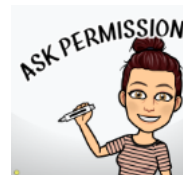

### TECHNIQUES

**Static Camera** = the camera is in a fixed position

**Zooming** = widen or narrow the focal point of the lens to get a closer or longer range view

**Pan** = from a fixed position, swivel the camera horizontally

**Tilt** = from a fixed position, swivel the camera vertically

**Animations & Transitions** = special effect transitions between video frames

**Visual Effects** = allowing changes in colour and brightness

**Music/Audio** = adding music to a video
