country	an area of land that is controlled by its own government.
city	a large town. London is a city.
population	number of people in a particular place

North West

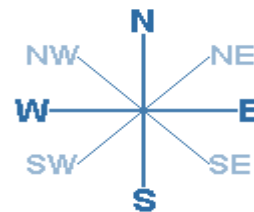
- Approximate population of 7 million

Eight Point Compass
