| Afterlife | Life after death |
| Eternity | Endless life after death |
| Faith | Having complete trust and confidence |
| Values | principles or standards of behaviour; one's judgement of what is important in life e.g. compassion (sympathetic pity and concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others) |
| Charity | the voluntary giving of help, typically in the form of money, to those in need |
| Kingdom of God | A realm associated with or regarded as being under the control of a particular person or thing e.g. God |
| Miracles | An event attributed the divine intervention of God |
| Parables | A simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson, as told by Jesus in the Gospel |
